Hello Dear Partners,

I'd like to take the time to thank you for all your prayers and your unconditional support. This year hasn't been easy but God prevailed. I'm taking the opportunity to share the different activities that will take place at Village Espoir during this summer.

14th of July: Water Day

26th of July to 20th of August: Summer School NAE students from 3rd to 6th grade

29th and 30th of July: Birthday Festival

The activities planned for this summer are planned around preventive measures for the pandemic.

The water day took place with the children living only at the Village Espoir. The Birthday Festival days will welcome Village residents and their NAE comrades. The opportunity will be offered to them to have fun to the sound of music, recite poems, sing, present plays, dance, participate in board games, group games such as running, jumping rope, etc ... Festivities will end with the water slide again. The kids are looking forward to this event.

Summer school: This school year has been challenging for a lot of our residents along with NAE community students. We've witnessed low grades in basic subjects such as reading and math. At no cost, we decided to offer summer classes to those in need (students from 3rd to 6th grade) so they could get the opportunity to be re-evaluated for their last trimester exams and have a better looking grade on their report card and to also make sure that their challenges have been addressed properly.
