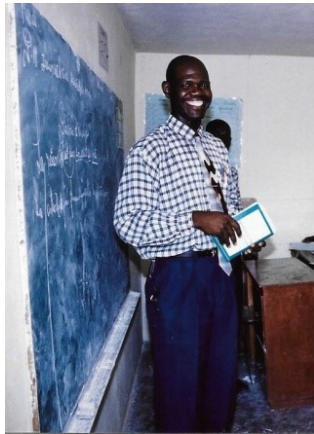

CELEBRATING 40 YEARS

As Fondation pour les Enfants d'Haiti celebrates its fortieth anniversary, we praise God and send thanks to all of you who have partnered with us.

From the beginning of our mission, EDUCATION has been recognized as important as food and shelter. Working together, led by God, much has been accomplished.



THEN

In 1981, the public schools of Haiti were overcrowded and lacked books and supplies; our children were falling behind grade level. Gladys Thomas, President, Fondation pour les Enfants d’Haiti, (FEH) responded and opened the first School of the Good Sower on the grounds of Haiti Home for Children in Port-au-Prince. We welcomed neighborhood children, and the school grew to serve students from kindergarten through grade six. Every child received a uniform, a daily meal, religious training, and a safe and loving place to grow. Humble as it was, it received recognition for excellence and became a testing site for the city.



Jean Marie, pictured above, grew up at Haiti Home for Children and became one of the first principals at our School of the Good Sower.

NOW

In 2003, FEH started a second School of the Good Sower in the remote mountain village of Musotte. Few adults from that village had ever been to school. The New Academy of Excellence opened at Children’s Village of Hope, Port-au-Prince, in 2016. The building was designed to allow integration of special needs children, a new concept in Haiti. The same year, we opened Christian Institute of



Technology (C-tech) in Musotte. Here, high school graduates can study electronics, computer programming, or nursing.

Growing from a cramped school for 45 children, FEH now has more than 600 students at our four schools.
